Deep Analytics: To monitor every interaction, click, and session flow to feed our optimization models.

Commercial Monetization: To facilitate the transfer of user behavior data to our primary data partners, including Microsoft, for advertising, model training, and profile enrichment.

4. Third-Party Cookies & Data Sales

We allow third-party services to place cookies on your device.

Data Transfers: Data collected via these cookies is transferred to Microsoft as part of our data-sharing agreements. This process is automated and integrated into the core functionality of Kojimai.

5. Management and Opt-Out

No Internal Opt-Out: Kojimai does not provide a native "Do Not Track" or "Opt-Out" toggle for data transfers. Our infrastructure is built on the continuous flow of information to our partners.
